



## Who is **Joan Miró**?

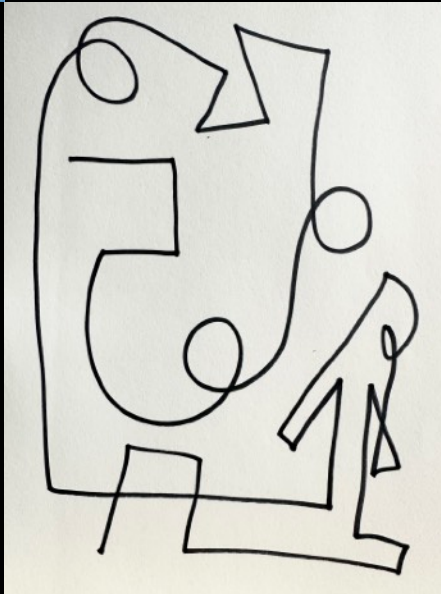
Miró was an artist best known for his **Surrealist** work. During his lifetime, he produced approximately 2,000 paintings, 500 sculptures, 400 ceramics, 5,000 drawings and 1,000 lithographs. He was born in Barcelona in 1893 and was 90 years old when he died. That's a lot of artwork in under 90 years!

## What is **Surrealism**?

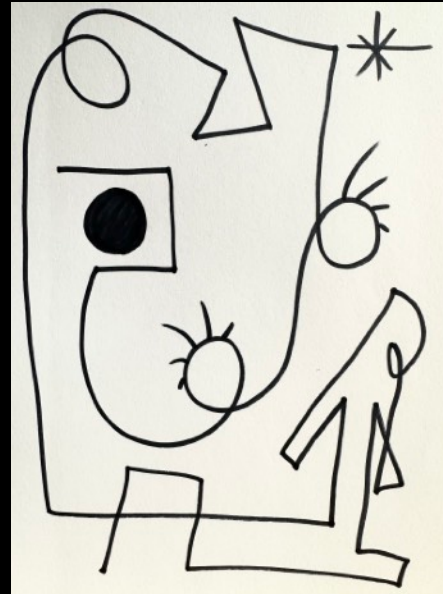
Surrealism is a style in art in which ideas are **dreamlike**, and don't need to make sense.

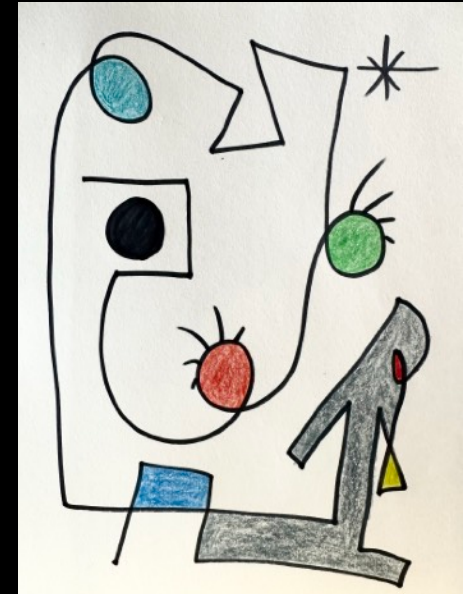

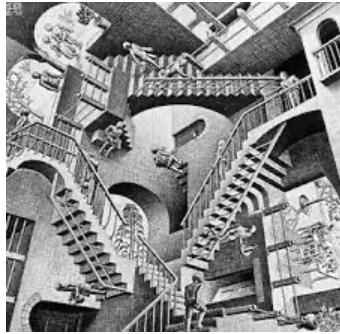


3. Color in the shapes
